CCD Expectations:

• Attendance: Excessive absences (3+) or excessive tardiness (5+) may result in students having to repeat the grade the next year. These cases will be discussed with Father Ranjan and the parents prior to decisions being made. If children are going to miss class, we ask the parents to contact the teacher for the lesson so they can remain current. You can text Shirley Hoelscher, 254-541-7950, and/or the teacher.

***If your child is in a Sacrament year, it is MOST important that they attend their classes as much as possible!! ***

**Parents will be notified after the 3rd absence... Teachers will be reaching out to parents if they see a pattern of absences and check on you and your child!

**For Parents of Sacrament classes only -- (*1st Grade Prep & 2nd Grades First Reconciliation & Communion & Confirmation Prep Years 1 & 2 - 7th-8th Grades) -- We understand that there will be scheduled parent meetings and/or retreats that *BOTH parents are required to attend (*unless otherwise communicated with teachers very early on)... We will attend scheduled events. Thank you!

*For all REP parents & students - Will you and your children be willing to participate & volunteer in helping during our yearly church Picnic and Spring Dinner? There will be assigned time slots to work during these events. Since we do not charge for REP, this is a great way to give back to St. Joseph's! Thank you!

- Follow Illness Protocol & Procedures --
 - **It is pretty simple -- If your child feels unwell and/or has a temp. of 99.5 or higher, please keep your child at home. Please let your teacher know and/or let Mrs. Hoelscher know. We can email and/or send the missed lesson to you to go over with your child! We hope they feel better soon!

- Ethics In Ministry Lessons Kinder. through Post Confirmation lessons will be completed during Sept./Oct. 2025 Lesson 4. More information is coming soon on this lesson!
- CYO (MS & HS) meetings will be held the first Wednesday of the month! Parents, please encourage your children to be a part of this great group! It is a service to our community and it will strengthen your child's walk with our Lord! We are hoping to make this group even more exciting for the upcoming year!!
- We are continuing to work on having ADORATION once a semester!! More news to come about that soon!
- Altar serving is a huge part of service to our church that we hope ALL students can be a part of once they complete the sacrament of First Communion (usually at the end of 2nd grade). If your child has completed the sacrament of First Communion, please discuss with your child this wonderful way to serve your church home! We need more servers and the more we have... the bigger rotation we will have so you only have to do it a few times a year! High school students AND Seniors are asked to stick with us until they graduate! We need YOU to mentor our little ones! They look UP to YOU -- Play on God's field, altar serve! -- Training dates will be posted soon!!
- High school students that attend REP on Wed's. get to help with the yearly VBS program and become leaders! Our little ones need to get to know our high school kids, & they look up to them! There will be some great activities planned for our high school students, they shouldn't miss out!!
- Baptismal certificates ARE REQUIRED for students enrolled in sacrament classes AND students transferring from another parish. Students attending classes here from another parish will have to bring a letter of consent from their pastor. Also, if you are transferring a student, Religious Education attendance records are required. Students must have attended the First Grade to be enrolled in First Communion Class and Seventh and Eighth Grades to be enrolled in Confirmation preparation classes. Unless other decisions have been determined. *Exceptions only in rare cases!
- If classes are canceled, parents will be contacted by Facebook message, email and/or phone. It is important for the REP office to have current phone #'s, email addresses and contact persons for emergency reasons. We will follow area school closings via radio/TV station notices for weather/other delays/cancellations...
- If we have any ongoing behavioral problems with a student, parents will be contacted. Parents must meet with the teacher and the coordinator to discuss the situation. If the problem persists, we will refer the student to the Priest, we will ask that the student not be allowed back to class until the teacher and coordinator are confident that the situation is resolved.

Class/Church Rules:

• Youth Sundays will be the third Sunday of each month, unless noted otherwise on the schedule. During Youth Sundays, students will help lead in praying the Rosary, will proclaim the scriptures at Mass / Lector, & help with being an Usher, Altar Servers, Presenters of the Gifts & will ask one question of Father Ranjan. The schedule is below of who is responsible for each month. The Wed. REP class before

Youth Sunday will be a time for those students to pick the part they will be responsible for and be given time to practice together as a class. The students that select the readings may have their teacher or parent stand up with them at Mass for comfort & reassurance. Copies of the readings will go home with readers to help them practice and get prepared ahead of time!

• All Youth should be at Youth Sunday early (*by 7:50am!) to fully participate in all parts of Youth Sunday Mass! Children will sit with their parents and will get up as needed to fulfill their responsibilities for Youth Sunday.

 - When in church, please show respect for God by sitting still and quiet, and saying the prayers of the Mass. When you show reverence to God in Church, that is what you are to do in Church, everyone else is respected!
 - Please show respect to your teacher and classmates. Teachers put time and effort into preparing lessons, and each time one stops to discipline a student or class, it disrespects the time and effort that the teacher has provided for their students. Remember, this is NOT a paying job; we are a group of volunteers working towards helping your children grow in their faith & walk with the Lord!
 - Please respect the property. Be quiet and still in church. Do not put your feet on the seats or back of the pew in front of you. Do not chew gum, drink or eat in church. When leaving church, no running, yelling, pushing or fighting. Enter the hall with respect for fellow students. Do not sit on tables or write on anything other than what is provided for you. There is to be no running in the hall nor is there to be any horseplay in the restrooms.
 - **Please do not wear hats or caps in the building during REP and/or Mass.**
 - Parents Please stay as quiet as you can in the hall during class time! We have wonderful student participation and our classrooms are overflowing and so we do have classes in the main part of the hall... Talking on your cell phone and/or talking with a fellow parent/parents may be distracting to our classes! Thank you for respecting our class time and remaining outside during class time or remaining quiet in the hall! We appreciate YOU! If you do come in early, remember... you CAN always go to your child's classroom to see what they are up to & get involved!

- Please let your children know that it may not be safe running around the church grounds after dusk/dark... We would NOT want them to get hurt (with vehicles coming & going) or possibly run into a snake. We will have the covered hard top lights on for the kids to run around on. Please speak with your kids about being safe outside!
 - Please do not bring anything to REP that is not conducive to a religious learning environment. <u>All Cell phones and iPods must be turned off or turned in to the REP teacher when entering class and are not to be turned back on until classes dismiss.</u>
 - <u>Do not bring candy, toys, sodas or gum to class</u>. REP Teachers will let you know about their snack preferences and if a snack will be made available. These may be provided for everyone when a teacher plans a party. Please make sure classrooms are clean when you leave. The Knights of Columbus may provide supper for the classes, volunteers and parents a few times during the year.
